

## How to Set up Pickleball Net Straps

The Pickleball and Tennis Clubs have worked together to replace the old bungee cords with straps. These straps attach to hooks that have been placed in the ground. This will make it much easier for players to set up the courts, and the straps do not do any damage to the nets. It's a win-win for us all!



- All Pickleball straps have a black line running down the center as shown above!!!
- Please **NEVER adjust or remove the Center Strap!!!** That is for tennis only!!!
- Please **NEVER hook anything to the nets!**

There are four straps that are kept in the smaller equipment box. Each strap has grommets at the end to attach to the hooks.

Please follow these simple steps to set them up:

1. Lay the strap over the top of the net, with the adjustment slides facing outward:



2. Hook the grommets onto the hook, ensuring the strap is not twisted:



3. The strap is now properly setup! Do not adjust the straps, they are checked regularly to ensure they are properly set.
